## Les Auron ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On this day came to be considered Plaintiffs' Verified Motion and Application for Temporary Restraining Order and Injunctive Relief (the "Motion"). After examining the verified pleadings and holding a hearing of which Defendant had notice, the Court finds that the requirements for the issuance of an extension of time under Chapter 166.046(g), as shown.

More specifically, the Court finds evidence that Plaintiff is entitled to the issuance of a Temporary Restraining Order to protect and preserve the status quo. Plaintiff is suffering and will continue to suffer irreparable harm if Defendant is permitted to remove life sustaining Translot treatment from Trinity Lewis. Plaintiff will be irreparably injured, and suffer loss and damage by likely death if life sustaining treatment is removed. Such harm is imminent because if an injunction is not entered, Defendant may remove The sustaining treatment on November 10, 2019, which will kill Trinity Lewis. Plaintiff has demonstrated a likelihood of success on the merits of this case and a balance of the equities strongly favors the granting of injunctive relief in order to preserve the status quo ante.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court issue a Temporary Restraining Order that Defendant and all of their respective agents, servants, employees, representatives, attorneys, and all persons, firms, corporations or other entities acting or purporting to act or acting in concert or in participation with them who gets actual notice of this Order by service or otherwise, are hereby ORDERED and ENJOINED to cease and desist all

Once this Order becomes effective, it shall remain in effect for a term of fourteen (14) days or until further order of this Court.

## **BOND**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court clerk, upon the filing of a bond in the amount of  $\frac{75^{--}}{2}$  (or cash deposit in lieu thereof) and on approving the same according to law, shall issue a Temporary Restraining Order in conformity with the law and the terms of this Order.

## TEMPORARY INJUNCTION HEARING AND TRIAL SETTING

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing on Plaintiffs' request for a Temporary Injunction is set before the <u>323</u> Judicial District Court, Tarrant County, Texas on the <u>Normanne</u> <u>22</u> day of <u>May</u> 2019, at <u>2</u> a.m. (p.m. in the <u>323</u> District Court's courtroom located 2701 Kinso Ro. (P) 7611 for in the Tarrant County Courthouse, 100 E Weatherford St, Fort Worth, TX 76196. The trial on the merits is set for the 157 day of 57.72, 2020

It is FINALLY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall issue all necessary writs.
