

Demonstrating the Policy and News Media Impact of the Research of Dr. Thaddeus M. Pope.

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The research of Dr. Thaddeus M. Pope has been referenced in resources issued by 31 different policy and news media organizations. Dr. Pope's work has been referenced in government documents by groups such as the European Commission and the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation (U.S. Department of Health and Human Services), and in work by non-governmental agencies including the Royal College of Physicians and the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence.

Dr. Pope's research has been referenced in popular media channels, including newspapers and websites. Their work has received attention through web sites, including Wikipedia, and news resources such as WHY-FM. It is likely that this does not represent the full impact of this work as this report is limited to resources which are currently available.
