
The First Court of Appeals has set the above cause for submission on **Tuesday, March 19, 2019, at 10:30 AM** in our Courtroom, 301 Fannin Street, Third Floor, North Courtroom, before a panel consisting of Chief Justice Radack, Justice Goodman and Justice Countiss, subject to change by the Court.

The Court will hear oral argument. Each side will be allowed **20** minutes to argue. TEX. R. APP. P. 39.8. The appellant may reserve part of its time for rebuttal. If you decide not to argue, please notify the Court at least 7 days prior to submission date.

Please notify the Court in writing via our electronic filing portal the name of the attorney that will be presenting argument to the Court. This notification should be submitted to the Court no later than the Thursday prior to the date your case is scheduled for argument. If you plan to present any oral argument exhibits to the Court, these must be submitted at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled argument and a twenty-five dollar filing fee per exhibit will apply. *See* TEXAS RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE, Appendix A. If you wish to utilize any of the Court's audio visual equipment located in the courtroom, please notify the clerk's office at least 24 hours prior to argument.

Persons with disabilities who plan to attend oral argument on this date and who may need auxiliary aids, accommodations or services, are requested to contact the Clerk of the Court, at (713) 274-2700 within 10 days after receipt of this letter so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
